

- *Reciprocal Supply*...Through meeting others' needs, we meet our own.
- *Constructive Contribution*...The work of God is to be done by the people of God giving according to the will of God.
- *Consistent Collection*...Consistent giving facilitates consistent ministry.
- *Personal Initiative*...Desire precedes duty in the grace of giving.
- Zealous Readiness...Zealous stewardship spreads like a powerful contagion.
- Graceful Abundance...Abundant grace brings abundant blessing and spurs abundant ministry.
- *Risky Management*...Trying to trick God will always trip you up.
- Unconditional Contentment... The steward's contentment is not dependent upon the steward's circumstances.
- *Godly Contentment*...Wise stewards are happy with what they have, not worried by what they do not have.
- *Absolute Harvest*...Sow bountifully, reap bountifully.
- *Single-minded Service*...One can serve God or serve money; no one can serve both.
- *Channeled Resources*...Stewards are the channels of an endless, eternal supply.
- *Loving compliance*...Pure obedience prompted by pure love produces pure stewardship.
