Generosity has an underlying theme of "stewardship," which means to manage someone else's property. Scripture proclaims that everything belongs to God; as Christians, we are managers of our Lord's property. Since everything belongs to Christ, we need to have the attitude that our things are His things. We are mere lessees of property, money, relationships, talents, time, physical body, spiritual gifts, and the life He has given us. That means all we are and all we have are not really ours. They belong to God. The duty of the Christian is not just a suggestion, but a responsibility and an accountability. We are to learn how to become responsible stewards of the resources our Lord has entrusted into our care. We are to manage everything to the best of our abilities for His glory. (1 Corinthians 4:2).
