The Holy Spirit gives Christians power to live on Mission. It is the will of God that everyone enjoys eternal life with Him in heaven (2 Peter 3:9).

God's method to bring the world to understand His plan is for Christians to allow the Holy Spirit to empower them to live on a mission to influence nonbelievers to place their faith in Jesus. Jesus' last words to believers right before He ascended into heaven were, "... you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." (Acts1:7b-8) The Good News – that forgiveness of our sins is possible by believing that Jesus took the penalty for our sins when He died on the cross – must be shared!



## **UNDERSTAND MISSIONS**
